ETIQUETTE ON THE COURSE

The Spirit of the Game

Consideration should be shown to all others on the course at all times. The game relies on the integrity of the persons playing. All players should behave in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy, and sportsmanship at all times. Proper and reasonably acceptable golf course and club attire is appreciated.

Safety

In the case of an emergency, call 911, then, notify the clubhouse immediately. Players should ensure that no one is standing in a position to be hit when they make a stroke or practice swing. Players should not begin play until those are out of range. Players should always alert others when they make a stroke where there is danger of hitting someone. Players should immediately shout the warning of "fore" in case of an errant stroke.

Weather

In the event of inclement weather, please seek shelter immediately. Under no circumstance should there be any play on the golf course when lightening. **Weather is ever-changing; please seek safe shelter when you notice signs of severe weather approaching.**

Pace of Play

Players should play at a good pace and be ready to begin play as soon as it is their turn. It is the group's responsibility to maintain pace with the group in front. Those delaying the play of the group behind should invite the group to play through.

Care of the Course

Before leaving a bunker, carefully smooth over all holes and footprints. Players should repair divot holes or damage to the putting surface made by the impact of the ball. **Players must remain respectful of the private property surrounding the golf course.**

Golf Carts

Golf carts must be operated responsibly and remain on golf course property and street right-a-ways. Abide by all directional signage. **Carts should remain on paths near tees and greens.** Children may not operate the cart or be left unattended with cart.

Food and Beverage

Florida law does not permit outside food and beverage to be available on golf and club property. Please contact the Pro Shop or visit The Pub for your food and beverage needs.

Practice Area

This area is available for practice and instruction by members and daily golf guests. Range balls are the property of the club and are for use in the designated practice range areas. At no time will yellow practice balls be permitted to be removed from the range area.

ETIQUETTE AT THE SPORTS CLUB

In the Spirit of Fun

Consideration should be shown to all others using the Halifax Plantation sports amenities. Everyone should behave in a disciplined manner, demonstrating courtesy, and integrity at all times. **This facility is for Halifax Plantation Golf Club registered members and guests only.** All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult Halifax Plantation club member. The number of guests is limited and management reserves the right to restrict guests as needed.

Safety

No lifeguard on duty-swim at your own risk. In case of an emergency, please call 911.

- All pool users must shower before entering the pool. Proper pool attire required. Infants must wear swim diapers.
- No diving, running, throwing of objects and rough play.
- No person suffering from a communicable disease transmissible via water or under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall use the pool.
- No spitting or bodily fluids in the pool.
- Bottles, glass and other hazardous objects that may in any way endanger the safety of others within the pool area are prohibited.
- No food, beverage or tobacco in pool or pool area. Florida law does not permit outside food and beverage to be available on golf and club property.
- No animals allowed with the exception of documented guide animals are allowed in the pool area.

Weather

Weather is ever-changing: please seek shelter when signs of severe weather are approaching. The entire pool area must be cleared.

Care of the Pool

Club Facilities are Subject to Down Time Pending Required Maintenance, Weather, Weather Related Conditions, or Acts of God. **The pool availability will vary throughout the year, with in-season (May-September) scheduled for 9:00am – 7:00pm.** Hours will be posted in the Sports Shop. Use of the facility is not available before scheduled opening or closing times.
